
## **Surgical Foundations CBD Faculty Tip Sheet**

## Did you know?

- Competency By Design (CBD) is being rolled out by the Royal College.
- Surgical Foundations (PGY1) is using CBD and has its own specific Entrustable Professional Activities or "EPAs".
- Each EPA is rated on a 5 point scale.
- Residents must achieve 2 entrustments (score = 4/Autonomy or 5/) for each EPA.
- EPAs are completed online using the Elentra platform.
- EPAs rely on your involvement.



## Pitfalls:

- It is often unrealistic to use an entire surgical procedure for PGY1 so use a component of a procedure e.g. "laparotomy" or "laparotomy closure".
- Entrustment level 4 states "supervisor didn't need to be there" for some faculty / specialties / procedures this is not (ever) possible, so please reflect on whether your presence was actually required.
- Try to avoid delays in completing the EPA documentation as the quality of feedback deteriorates with time.

## How to Perform an EPA:

- 1. PGY1 and Faculty identify an opportunity to conduct an EPA.
- 2. Faculty directly observes PGY1 during the encounter, wherever possible.
- Faculty provides immediate feedback and completes EPA on resident's or own smartphone using Elentra.
